SEWER MAINLINE & LATERAL JOINT GROUTING

Understanding the need to stop infiltration at all sources, Equix Integrity offers mainline joint grouting, manhole grouting, and lateral joint grouting using packers and state-of-the-art CCTV, test, and seal trucks. Chemical grout is injected into a leaking joint to form a watertight barrier. Our team drills manholes in multiple areas, and a pump injects the grout to blanket the entire manhole sealing all leaks from weepers to gushers.

- Manhole, chamber and large diameter pipeline grouting by way of confined space entry
- No disruption to the mainline or service lateral during grouting. In most cases, bypass is not required.
- Sanitary and storm sewer joint grouting in pipes ranging from 6" to 60" in diameter. Lateral grout up to 12' and post CIPP grouting to fill annular space.
- Multiple Certified Avanti Applicators capable of handling, storing, mixing, and transporting various products
- Experienced staff who completed Avanti 300 Municipal Grout School
- Can be used to blanket grout entire manholes, target joint sealing and pipe seals in manholes, mainline joints, lateral joints, and structural defects

MANHOLE REHABILITATION

Equix Integrity's highly skilled manhole rehab crews rehabilitate aging manholes, wet wells, tanks, and catch basins eliminating the cost and time needed to dig and replace them. We utilize industry leading spray-on application cement spray trailers and have the ability to hand apply in extremely difficult easements. Using cementitious applications with corrosion inhibitors to defend against H₂S damage, as well epoxy, Equix ensures the life and integrity of every structure our team rehabilitates.

- Employees certified to apply multiple different products of cementitious and epoxy liners
- Applications include hand spray, hand apply, and spin casting to safely and successfully rehabilitate manholes located in roadways and the deepest easements
- Ability to introduce H₂S inhibitors to help prevent damage to cementitious surfaces caused by gas
- Ability to apply up to 2" of cementitious liner and rebuild bench and channel within structure



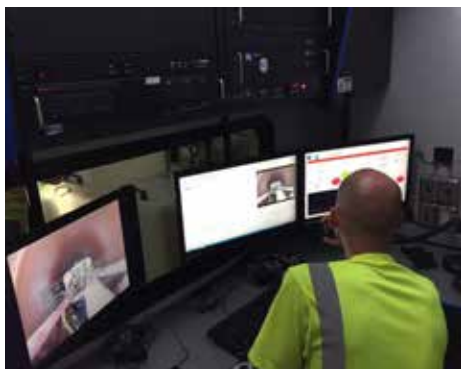


CLEAN & INSPECTION

Our LACP and PACP trained management team, administrators, and field team utilize advanced mainline closed-circuit television (CCTV) trucks, lateral launch trucks, push cameras, CCTV software, and locators. This allows us to provide LACP- and PACP-certified inspections, as well as lateral and mainline tracing and location to our customers, while delivering the most detailed and accurate reports and deliverables.

CCTV is used to find:

- Inflow and infiltration (I/I)
- Debris
- Roots, Grease and Attached Deposits
- Structural Defects
- Construction Features

CROSS BORE

Equix stands at the forefront of public protection with our underground utility infrastructure services. Our team offers cross bore inspection services to mitigate the risk of interfering with other underground utility lines, such as sewer and natural gas pipelines. Our inspection services use CCTV-inspection trucks and remotely controlled cameras to document the utility lines in question.

CIPP

Equix Integrity stands out with cured-in-place point repair as an alternative method to full length CIPP. Equix's experienced staff utilizing CCTV and Steam trucks accurately pull the section of liner to the damaged section of the host pipe. The liner is then impregnated, cured, and televised to insure proper installation. This technology strengthens and seals the deteriorated or damaged portion of the host pipe, allowing the pipe to support soil and live loads.

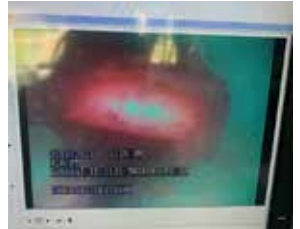
